The A.R.S. “Roubina” chapter of Toronto has been awarding University Scholarships since 1997, as part of its educational program.

The following scholarships are awarded annually:

- Two (2) scholarships for first year university students.
- One (1) scholarship for post graduate university students (Master or PhD).
- “Tro Najarian” scholarship for university students in any program: Bachelor, Master or PhD.

The awards will be based on scholastic achievements and community involvement.

1. Applicants should meet the following requirements:

- They should reside in Ontario.
- They should have an acceptance from a University as a full time student.
- They should not be related to any member of the ARS “Roubina” Chapter Executive Board or Scholarship Committee.

2. Applicants must supply the following documents:

- Acceptance letter from the university of their choice.
- Secondary school or university transcripts as the case may be.
- Two letters of reference, one from the education institution they have attended, and the second from an Armenian organization.
