

## ARMENIAN RELIEF SOCIETY "ROUBINA" CHAPTER, TORONTO SCHOLARSHIPS

The ARS "Roubina" Chapter of Toronto has been awarding University Scholarships since 1997, as part of its educational program.

The following scholarships are awarded annually:

- Two (2) scholarships for first year university students
- One (1) scholarship for any year university student
- One (1) scholarship for a post graduate university student (Master or PhD)
- "Tro Najarian" Scholarship for a university student in any program: Bachelor, Master or PhD
- "Kololian" Scholarship for a university student pursuing a teaching degree

The scholarships will be based on scholastic achievements and community involvement.

- 1. Applicants should meet the following requirements:
  - They should reside in Ontario
  - They should have an acceptance from a university as a full-time student
  - They should not be related to any member of the ARS "Roubina" Chapter Scholarship Committee
  - Another family member (i.e. sibling) has not applied for a scholarship in the same year
- 2. Applicants must supply the following documents:
  - Acceptance letter from the university of their choice
  - Secondary school or university transcripts as the case may be
  - Two letters of reference, one from the educational institution they have attended, and the second from an Armenian organization
